# Navigation and Ecosystem Sustainability Program




- Two modern locks at Peoria and LaGrange (no new dams). Completion date is beyond 2025
- Additional mooring cells and navigation enhancements (could be completed < 10 years)</li>
- Adaptive implementation of several ecosystem restoration projects of less than \$25 million each
