





Upper Mississippi River

The "Win-Win" Solution:

Wetland Restoration

- 1) Provides habitat for waterfowl
- 2) Removes excessive nutrients

- IL River Road Scenic Byway













Gimlet Creek

3,600 ac. Watershed












Wetlands Reserve Enhancement Program (WREP)




- Approved under NRCS's Mississippi River Basin Initiative
- Provides \$3,200/acre for cropland in the 100 yr. floodplain.
- Ducks Unlimited develops restoration plan with NRCS.
- Covers 100% of landowner's wetland restoration cost.













Current Challenges:

- 1) \$3,200/acre easement rate too low.
- 2) Eligibility criteria precludes some lands.
- 3) "Non-standard" restoration practices.
