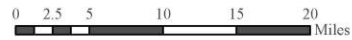
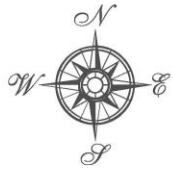
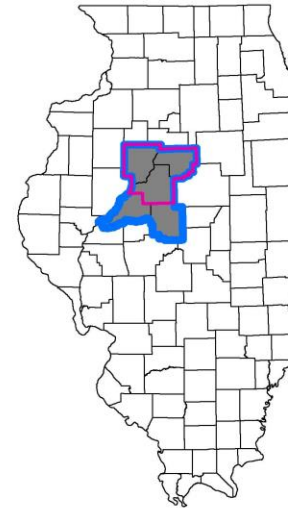


Focus Forward Central Illinois Jurisdictional Map
